Austin Peay State University 2011 Tailgate Alley Guidelines

To enhance the Game Day experience, to make sure that Game Days are safe for everyone, and to preserve the beauty of the campus, Austin Peay Athletics encourages responsible tailgating and offers the following guidelines.

- 1. Individuals, groups, and organizations hosting or participating in tailgate parties are responsible for their own conduct and are expected to respect the rights of others and the entire University community. Students will be expected to adhere to Code of Conduct.
- 2. Parking is restricted to one vehicle per assigned tailgate location. Do not park or drive on sidewalks or lawns.
- 3. Be aware of other tailgaters when driving through the lot. Speed will be monitored by uniformed officers.
- 4. Tents should be confined to the space allowed for each tailgating area and may be erected on game days only.
- 5. Observe safe principles of operation of barbeque pits and open-flame cooking. Properly store flammable liquids.
- 6. The Tennessee Board of Regents prohibits the use and/or possession of alcohol on institution owned or controlled property.
- 7. The University and the Athletics Department are not responsible for items left unattended.
- 8. Pick up after yourself and your party. Properly dispose of any trash.
- 9. Groups bringing music (bands, dj's, etc.) need to get approval first from Athletic Director.
- 10. Please be respectful to others around you and remember this is a family atmosphere. Parents should be responsible for their children. Children are required to be supervised by an adult while at inflatables.
- 11. At its discretion, the University may terminate or take other appropriate action against individuals, groups, or organizations whose conduct at tailgate parties is irresponsible, unreasonable, or inconsistent with University policies and regulations, ordinances and laws.
- 12. There will be no charge for reservations; however a no-show policy will go into effect:
 - Reservation cancellations must be received in writing no later than 4:30 p.m. the day prior to avoid a no-show.
 - After two no-shows, all future reservations for the season will be cancelled.
 - Notify the Athletic Department if you will be transferring you tailgate location to another person/group.
