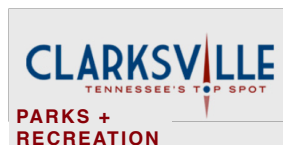

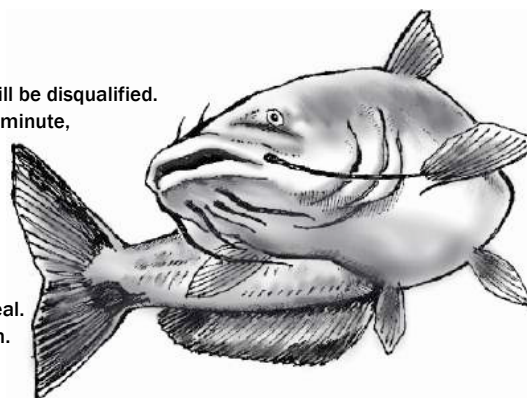
*Registration begins at 6:30 p.m. *Blast off at 8:00 p.m. *Weigh In at 7:00 a.m.

Entry fee: \$100 per boat (2 person), (\$110 after Sept 7th)
\$50 per extra person not to exceed 4 people per boat
70 % payback (minimum of 3 places)
Big Fish Pot: \$10 per boat 100% payback
Door Prizes awarded



Rules and Regulations

- No consumption of alcohol or illegal drugs before or during tournament.
- All boats must meet Coast Guard specifications.
- Catfish must be alive to be weighed in. ½ pound penalty per dead fish.
- All catfish must be caught alive in a conventional sporting manner (rod and reel) no limb lines, trotlines, jugs, nets, etc.
- Each team may only weigh-in (5) fish.
- Short fish will lose that fish weight toward the cumulative weight and (1) pound penalty.
- All species of catfish may weigh in and have to be 12 inches in minimum length.
- Culling begins on the (6th) fish. Teams returning to weigh-in area with more than (5) fish will be disqualified.
- Anyone that checks in after their weigh-in time will receive a late penalty of (1) pound per minute,
- Anyone more than (15) minutes late will be disqualified.
- All angling must be conducted from a boat.
- Each person on boat must be a paid contestant and not exceed 4 persons on boat.
- Entry form with complete entry must be received before fishing.
- Any recipient of prize money could be subjected to a lie detector test.
- Protest must be made in writing before closing of scales.
- Decisions of the tournament director are final in all matters and are not subjected to appeal.
- It is the responsibility of the boat owner to have the appropriate insurance and registration.
- It is the responsibility of the contestants to have the appropriate licenses and such.
- No refund or substitution of entry fee for any reason.
- Participants agree to hold harmless The City of Clarksville, Riverfest, TWRF and employees, heirs and sponsors.
- Boater and/or partners are responsible for their own actions; accidental or intentional.
