Rules and Regulations

No consumption of alcohol or illegal drugs before or during tournament.

- > All boats must meet Coast Guard specifications.
- ➢ Boats must have adequate live well to keep fish alive. Dead fish will result in a penalty of ½ pound per dead fish.
- > Artificial baits only, with the exception of pork trailers. All bass must be caught alive in a conventional sporting manner.
- Each team may only weigh-in (5) fish. Fish will be measured on a golden rule board.
- Short fish will lose that fish weight toward the cumulative weight and (1) pound penalty.
- Largemouth, Smallmouth, and spots have to be 15"
- > Culling begins on the (6th) fish. Teams returning to weigh-in area with more than (5) fish will be disqualified.
- Anyone that checks in after their weigh-in time will receive a late penalty of (1) pound per minute,
- > Anyone more than (15) minutes late will be disqualified.
- > All angling must be conducted from a boat.
- Each person on boat must be a paid contestant and not exceed 2 people.
- Entry form with complete entry must be received before fishing.
- Any recipient of prize money could be subjected to a lie detector test.
- Protest must be made in writing before closing of scales.
- Decisions of the tournament director are final in all matters and are not subjected to appeal.
- > It is the responsibility of the boat owner to have the appropriate insurance and registration.
- > It is the responsibility of the contestants to have the appropriate licenses and such.
- No refund or substitution of entry fee for any reason.
- > Participants agree to hold harmless The City of Clarksville, Riverfest, TWRF and employees, heirs and sponsors.
- ➢ Boater and/or partner are responsible for their own actions; accidental or intentional.
