Austin Peay State University head coach **Gary McClure** is entering his 28th year at the helm of the Govs baseball program. In 2014, McClure achieved what no other coach in OVC history has accomplished by acquiring his 800th win as head coach. In

2013, the Govs made their sixth NCAA appearance and first-ever No. 2 Seed in the Bloomington Regional. In 2012, during the Eugene Regional, the Govs were the first OVC team to win two games in a single regional, and accomplished the feat again in 2013 at Bloomington. During his tenure at Austin Peav, the Govs have achieved 19 of the program's 23 league tournament appearances. He led the 1996 squad to APSU's first-ever NCAA Division I tournament appearance. In addition, 14 of his teams have posted 30-win seasons, including a school-record 47-win campaign by that storied 2013 squad. The new century has seen Austin Peay's baseball team reach greater heights as it opened the 2000s with 30-win seasons in 2000, '01, '02, '04, '05, '07, '11, '12 and '13. During that span the Govs have won five OVC regular-season titles (2003, '04, '07, '11, and '12) and five OVC tournament crowns (2005, '07, '11, '12, and '13).
